Supervisor Dennis Mahus called the regular meeting of the North Dansville Town Board to order at 7:00 PM. Roll was taken and found Councilperson Horr, Infantino, Bacon and Luce present. Highway Superintendent MacWhorter was also in attendance.

Pledge to the Flag was led by Scout Devin Peck.

Minutes from the April 13, 2021, regular meeting were presented, copy on file. A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Infantino to accept the minutes as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Privilege of Floor: Dave Roberts stated that the Union Hose Co. will meet May 26, 2021, to decide if they will host the annual tractor pull for 2021. The Pulling Tractor Association will meet May 22, 2021, to decide if they will conduct the Union Hose Tractor Pull. More info to follow.

Town Clerk's report for the month of April 2021 was presented, copy on file. The report shows monies taken in for the month were \$3,073.00 of which \$1,690.70 was turned over to the Supervisor. A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Bacon to accept the report as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Code/Zoning Enforcement Officers report: Code report for April 2021 was presented. A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Luce to accept the report as presented. All in Favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Justice reports from Justice Werth and Weidman for the month of April 2021 were presented, copies on file. The reports show monies taken in for the months were \$7,745.00 and \$4,645.00 respectfully. A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Luce to accept the reports as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Town /Village Planning Board; No report

Town/Village Zoning Board of Appeals: Minutes from the March 15, 2021, meeting of the Town/Village Zoning Board of Appeals were presented, copy on file. A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Infantino to accept the minutes as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Executive Summary report for the month of April 2021 was presented, copy on file. A motion by Councilperson Luce and a second by Councilperson Bacon to accept the report as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Cemetery report for the month April 2021 was presented, copy on file. A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Luce to accept the report as presented. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Highway Superintendent MacWhorter states that they are trying to keep up on the mowing at the cemetery.

Highway: Highway Superintendent MacWhorter stated that Scott has been working for Livingston County. He has also been hauling stone for the Town's CHIPS Road work reimbursement program. MacWhorter informed the board that the roads that will have work done under Chips will be Cemetery Rd, a small portion of Greenmount Ave (Towns), Frontage Rd. and the rest of Cumminsville (that was not completed last year.) Supervisor Mahus informed board members that the new highway worker will be Joseph Werth. Mahus stated that there are several Towns looking for highway operators and we were lucky to get Mr. Werth. Werth has a class A license and has operated equipment similar to our equipment. Mahus would like to set the rate of \$20.00 per hour for Mr. Werth and raise Scott Mitchell's rate to \$22.00 per hour. He would also like to hire a part-time person from the existing list of applicants, train that person and assist him in getting his CDL license with the purpose of having a trained employee that we would hope to hire full time if and when another position is open.

A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Horr to accept Joseph Werth as the new highway employee at a rate of \$20.00 per hour, raise Scott Mitchell's rate to \$22.00

per hour and to hire and train a person from the existing posted job list with the intent to, if and when a job opens up, hire that person full time. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Airport: Supervisor Mahus stated he would like to see the Town look into an outside security camera system at the airport. We have approximately \$13,000.00 to spend.

Correspondence:

Acceptance letters were received for funding from the Livingston County First Impression Program for the work at 191 Main St.

Three (3) emails from Charter Communications informing the Town of changes to the cable services provided by Spectrum Northeast LLC.

Email (information) received by board that NYS Celebrates Arbor Day and awards additional \$1.18 million Urban and Community Forestry Grants.

A flyer was received from Livingston County IDA pertaining to a Restaurant Revitalization Grant that is being offered under the American Rescue Plan.

Recreation Park (Dansville Rec. Park): Supervisor Mahus informed the board that the fireman's arch located over Frontage Rd. needs to be repaired or removed. The arch has not been used in years and was put up by the Union Hose Fire Co. This concern will be given to the Union Hose.

Review of monthly payroll summary/registers and bank statements: E-mails were sent to all board members Reconciliation Summary of Banking Accounts and Bank Statements (General, Highway, Airport, Water District and Trust & Agency) for the period ending April 30, 2021, for their review. Town Clerk presented a hard copy of these materials for board review if they so wished. Board members had no concerns with the information contained in the financial material

Solar Energy Law: Supervisor Mahus stated he would like to get the proposed Solar Energy Law to the Livingston County Planning Board for their review and or comments. A motion by Councilperson Horr and a second by Councilperson Luce to send the proposed Solar Energy Law to the Livingston County Planning Board for their review and or comments after the June meeting. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Forestry Conservation Plan Review: A motion by Councilperson Infantino and a second by Councilperson Bacon to hold a public Hearing on the proposed Forestry Conservation Plan on June 08, 2021, at 07:00pm in the North Dansville Town Hall and to instruct the Town Clerk post a legal notice in one issue of the Genesee Country Express of said public hearing. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED. This plan will be an "Unlisted Action" for the SEQR review process parts 2 & 3.

Clerk Wolfanger informed board members that Jessica Nolan (No Mess with Jess Cleaning) will be on vacation from May 24 – May 28. In her absence Dawn Schleyer will be doing the cleaning in the Town Hall.

A motion by Councilperson Luce and a second by Councilperson Bacon to pay all bills as audited, General Account Vouchers #82-#100 incl., totaling \$20,379.29 and Highway Account Vouchers # 29-#33 incl., totaling \$2,589.66. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Deputy Supervisor requested a job description from the Town Clerk for the Clerk's job.

A motion by Councilperson Bacon and a second by Councilperson Infantino to adjourn. All in favor. MOTION CARRIED
