Airport: Supervisor Mahus informed board members that the Town will receive \$30,000.00 for work and equipment at the airport under the "Cares Act". The town will be looking to purchase a new zero turn mower for the airport as well as other airport expenses.

The airport roof repair bid has been put on hold, as there is no one at the State DOT to review the bids.

Recreation Park (Dansville Rec. Park): Highway Superintendent MacWhorter stated he has removed people that set up campsites in the park. A wood stove was left behind and is presently at the Town barns.

Review of monthly payroll summary/registers and bank statements: E-mails were sent to all board members Reconciliation Summary of Banking Accounts and Bank Statements (General, Highway, Airport, Water District and Trust & Agency) for the period ending April 30, 2020 for their review. Town Clerk presented a hard copy of these materials for board review if they so wished. Board members had no concerns with the information contained in the financial material
